## HUMBLE I.S.D. TURNER STADIUM RULES AND REGULATIONS

Listed below are the rules and regulations that must be adhered to while in our facility. We do appreciate your cooperation of these policies.

- 1. Gates will open 90 minutes prior to game time for spectators. The home ticket booth is located on the northwest side of the stadium. The visitor gate is located on the northeast side of the stadium.
- 2. Spectators will not be allowed to leave the stadium and return without purchasing another ticket.
- 3. State laws and school district policies will be in effect concerning alcoholic beverages and controlled substances
- 4. No outside food or drink may be brought into the stadium.
- 5. The use of tobacco products in any form is prohibited on all school district property.
- 6. Fireworks, confetti, animals, skateboards, bicycles, balls, Frisbees, etc are not permitted inside the stadium.
- 7. Air-horns, bells, whistles and mechanical noisemakers are not permitted inside the stadium.
- 8. Tailgate parties must have prior approval of the Humble I.S.D. Athletic office.
- 9. Food, drinks, gum, sunflower seeds are prohibited at all times around or on the field area.
- 10. Only emergency vehicles may enter the stadium area.
- 11. No loitering will be permitted. Spectators must sit in the stands and keep off the rails. Aisles should be kept clear at all times. Only adults will be allowed to crossover and this will only be allowed at halftime.
- 12. Spirit items may only be thrown into the stands during the last two minutes of the game.
- 13. Bags, backpacks, coolers, etc are not allowed in the stadium. Purses may be inspected for security purposes.
- 14. Patrons must enter and remain fully clothed at all times.
- 15. Umbrellas are prohibited inside the facility. This is a courtesy for fan viewing and safety.
- 16. Victory lines shall be limited to uniformed support groups unless prior approval from the Athletic office.
- 17. Only authorized personnel will be allowed to enter the field, press box, and field house areas. Individuals must have proper credentials for access. Passes must be requested in advance from the Humble ISD Athletic office.
- 18. Pre-game / Half-time activities must be approved by the District Athletic Director at least two week in advance. Activities include, but are not limited to, Band and Football parent night, homecoming activities and any other activities associated with the contest that are to be done at the stadium.
- 19. Coaches' wives and families are not allowed on the field after the game. They may visit in front of the locker room by going through the gate nearest the north concessions/restrooms.
- 20. Booster clubs associated with the contest may sell items on their side of the stadium with approval from the Humble ISD Athletic office. Please call 281-641-8132 in advance to arrange for tables and chairs.
- 21. All stadium or field usage requests should be scheduled through the Athletic Office. The stadium is available for rentals to outside groups. For more information please call 281-641-8132 or visit www.humble.k12.tx.us/maintenance\_rentals.htm
